































Heights Remembers Veterans Day

On Tuesday, November 11, at Memorial Park, a brief service was held at 11 a.m. The service was led by American Legion Commander Mike Cahill, prayers were said by Service Officer Tom McQuade and Gil Hunt provided the closing prayer.

The annual program is co-sponsored by VFW Post 4591 and the American Legion.

Origins: In 1921, an unknown World War I American soldier was buried in Arlington National Cemetery. Similar ceremonies occurred earlier in England and France, where an unknown soldier was buried in each nation's highest place of honor (in England, Westminster Abbey; in France, the Arc de Triomphe).

These memorial services took place on November 11, the anniversary of the end of World War I at 11:00 a.m., November 11, 1918 (the 11th hour of the 11th day of the 11th month), which became known as Armistice Day.

Armistice Day officially became a holiday in the US in 1926, and a national holiday 12 years later. On June 1, 1954, the name was changed to Veterans Day to honor all US veterans.

In 1968, new legislation changed the national commemoration of Veterans Day to the fourth Monday in October. It soon became apparent, however, that November 11 was a date of historic significance to many Americans. Therefore, in 1978 Congress returned the observance to its traditional date.

Official national ceremonies for Veterans Day center around

the Tomb of the Unknowns.

To honor these men, symbolic of all Americans who gave their lives in all wars, an Army honor guard, the 3rd U.S. Infantry (*The Old Guard*), keeps day and night vigil.

At 11 a.m. on November 11, a combined color guard representing all military services executes "Present Arms" at the tomb. The nation's tribute to its war dead is symbolized by the laying of a presidential wreath and the playing of "Taps."



were reported.


During an alarm of this type, the Fire Department performs many activities simultaneously under the Fire Chief's command—equipment is deployed, rescue teams search the home, hoses are connected, activated and brought in to attack the fire from the inside, ladder companies vent as needed, "F.A.S.T. Teams" are on standby to assist trapped firefighters, EMS is on standby, support personnel

are ready (help change air tanks, get tools, etc.), equipment and personnel from other communities are positioned at the fire house to respond to other emergencies, etc.

The ability to mobilize the equipment and personnel in short response time, and to activate these resources in an efficient manner to serve our community during such an emergency, represents hours of training the department.


